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The Hebert B. Holtzman Englewood Dental Center Ribbon Cutting

North Hudson Community Action Corporation opened the Dr. Herbert B. Holtzman Englewood Dental Center in its health center in Englewood with assistance from the Holtzman family, Englewood Hospital, and Michael Wildes, Englewood Mayor on Monday, November 25th, 2019.

The late Dr. Holtzman had had a dental practice affiliated with Englewood Hospital in the town for many years before his retirement. His two daughters, Jill Eisenberg and Amy Claman, were saddened when the Hospital closed its dental clinic and determined to do something to continue their father's legacy.

When they approached North Hudson, CEO Joan Quigley told them how expensive it was to launch a dental service and how few resources were available to FQHC's. The women rose to the challenge and offered to raise at least \$100,000 to get things started. The trustees of the North Hudson Foundation offered another \$50,000 and Englewood Hospital agreed to make more space available in the FQHC building leased to them.

Then the North Hudson – Englewood Hospital partnership grew even stronger when the FQHC supported the hospital's application for a dental residency program, which was granted and will begin in July 2020.

Eighteen months of fund-raising, planning, designing and building came to a conclusion on November 25th when Mayor Wildes, Michael Pietrowicz of Englewood Hospital, Joan Quigley and a bevy of Holtzman family members cut the ribbon on the new center on South Van Brunt Street.
